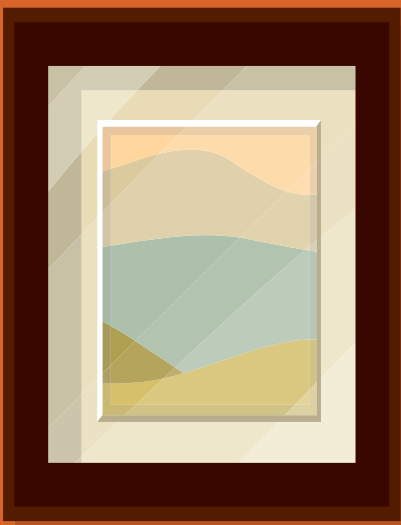


“Use the right hardware to protect your walls and the artwork.”



Choose a primary wall to highlight the art. By cutting a piece of butcher paper the same size as the picture, you'll be able to practice placing the size in different locations. Regardless of the size of the piece, allow at least 4 inches between the top and the ceiling and allow 6 to 8 inches between the bottom and any furniture placed against the wall.

Smaller pieces should be hung so that a person of average height will be eye-level with the piece's center. Before hanging, consider factors that may damage the work. Moisture in kitchens and bathrooms, heat and soot from fireplaces and direct sunlight can be destructive to delicate art.

Once you've determined placement, follow these easy steps:

1. Attach hardware if needed. If a piece is framed, the D-rings should be attached to the sides (not the top) of the frame. If you are unsure about putting in the screws, take it to a professional.
2. Measure from the ceiling to where you'd like the work to hang.
3. Holding the wire a foot apart with two fingers from each hand, have a friend measure from your fingers to the top of the piece.
4. Add these two measurements. Mark the wall at the sum, and then mark 6 inches to the left and right. Adjust spacing for larger pieces.
5. Position and hammer in picture hooks at the right and left marks, using the level if necessary.
6. Carefully lift the art, and ensure that the wire catches on both hooks.
7. Use a level to ensure the piece is hung perfectly.
